Dear Second Year Practical Nursing Student:

Hello from the Practical Nursing Faculty. By now, you know that you have progressed into semester 3 of the Practical Nursing Program. Congratulations!!!! You worked very hard during semesters 1 and 2. Hopefully, the summer will give you some time to revitalize for the fall.

Year two starts Tuesday September 7, 2010. It is therefore imperative that you complete the following tasks before returning to school in the fall.

1. Unfinished Courses

If you did not complete any of your support service courses, specifically CMM 125, CMM 190, PSY 100 and/or your General Education Credit (for many of you this will be SOC 100) you must enroll yourself in a 2010 summer course!!!! Call part-time studies at Canadore (extension 5420) for assistance with this.

Remember.....As per the Student Success Guide, you cannot go into Semester 4, January 2011, without successfully completing these support service courses, with a passing grade of C.

**For those of who have requested transfer credits for these courses, please confirm that these are reflected on your transcripts by accessing your Banner Account.

2. CPR

It is your responsibility to ensure your CPR certificate (Level C - basic rescuer) is current. Certificates with a three year expiry date will be accepted as long as the expiry date is relevant and clearly marked on the certification card. Students whose cards do not indicate an expiry date are required to recertify annually. If you have to recertify over the summer, you must bring two photocopies of your CPR certificate with you on the first day of school in the fall. **You will not be permitted to enter any clinical practice setting without a current CPR Level C certificate.**

3. Health Requirements

For returning Canadore practical nursing students - College Drive Campus

In order to attend the clinical setting, you must have an updated clearance card. This should have already been updated in spring of 2010. If you did not update your clearance card, you must contact the Campus Health Centre immediately to make arrangements (extension 5261). **You will not be permitted to enter any clinical practice setting without an updated Clearance Card.**

For returning Canadore practical nursing students - Parry Sound

In order to attend the clinical setting, you must have an updated clearance card. This should have already been updated in spring of 2010. If you did not update your clearance card, you must contact the Campus Health Centre or staff at the Parry Sound Canadore Campus immediately to make arrangements. **You will not be permitted to enter any clinical practice setting without an updated Clearance Card.**

For students transferring into practical nursing from other programs

You must download our program medical/immunization form from the following [link???? \(Help Terry\)](#) Over the summer months, you must have your physician complete it with you. This completed form must then be provided to the Campus Health Centre by August 16, 2010. Upon receipt of your completed form, the Campus Health Centre will issue you a “Clearance Card”, which indicates you have been deemed safe for patient contact. **You will not be permitted to enter any clinical practice setting without a clearance card from the Campus Health Centre.**

4. Criminal Checks

All clinical facilities are requiring that students have a police check/criminal record check completed during the month of August 2010. (Any criminal checks dated before August 2010 will not be accepted) Please bring two photocopies of this with you on the first day of school. **You will not be permitted to enter any clinical practice setting without a completed police check.**

Registration and classes will be held on September 7, 2010. We will be busy with new and exciting content/clinical immediately.

The faculty will be away for the summer months from mid June until mid August 2010. If you having questions or concerns during this time please contact the School of Health Sciences at extension 5170. Enjoy your summer.
